### Flexibilities Ending When Proposed Rule #22005 is Effective.

#### The rule is currently expected to be effective July 1, 2023

*HHSC has completed further analysis of clinical appropriateness and cost-effectiveness and has considered stakeholder input on the following Medicaid and CHIP flexibilities. The adopted rules are expected to publish in May 2023, and policies outlined in the rules will be effective July 1, 2023.*
